Domaine BATARD-LANGALIER, Muscadet, Loire

A family estate 30 miles SW of Nantes, influenced by the Oceanic climate with grapes from a range of parcels with soils of metamorphic rock. The vineyard is managed according to organic farming, no synthetic treatments are applied in the vineyard and some biodynamic practices are followed.

100% Melon de Bourgogne, with a very intense nose of exotic fruits; fresh, salty and tense. Fab.

Quinta do Montalto, Lisbon, Portugal

The farm of Montalto, owned by the same family for five generations, encourages biodiversity with fifty hectares covering vineyards, olive yard, orchards and forest. Part of the wider viticultural region of Lisbon and certified organic since 1997. The Filas wines are produced using traditional oenological practices. No chemical fertilizers, herbicides, insecticides, fungicides or other synthesised chemical products have been used.

Natural, fresh, Atlantic influenced white from native Fernao Pires and Siria grapes. Characterful, good texture the vineyard uses biodynamic practices and certified organic for over 20 years. 12% ABV

Les Vignerons d'Estezargues, Rhone, France

Les Vignerons D' Estézargues is a co-operative cellar in the small town of Estézargues which is located near Avignon. Les Vignerons D'Estézargues is truly unique in the wine world. They take a fundamentally different approach to most wine co-operatives; starting in 1995 the ten different growers in this co-op began to vinify their wine separately and make single cuvées from their best plots. On the heels of the single cuvée evolution Les Vignerons D' Estézargues began to practice natural winemaking. Possibly one of the only co-ops in the world to do so, Les Vignerons D' Estézargues uses no external yeasts, no filtering, no fining and no enzymes are employed on the grapes during the winemaking process.

50% Grenache; 50% Syrah / Carignan. Purple, soft, juicy with blackberry and black pepper flavours. 14% ABV.

La Bodega de las Estrellas, Vino de la Tierre de Castilla, Spain

Literally - 'The Winery of the Stars', in Valdepenas with wines released under the IGP Tierra de Castilla. Specialists in fermenting and aging wines in vast (up to 5000 litre) centuries old clay amphorae (Tinajas) in huge purpose-built caves. Natural wines, certified organic by CAAE and vegan certified; very closely following the lunar calendar and biodynamic principles. No added sulphites, lab yeasts or any other artificial substances. Our oenological practices are unsophisticated but careful and exhaustive giving the right relevance to the direct and honest character of the wines.

These wines were available under the VinNaturo label in previous vintages. Great to have them back!

A blend of aromatic Airen and Macabeo which brings freshness + balanced acidity. Wild yeast fermentation in vast Tinajas and low 20mg/ litre added sulphites. A super easy bright light fresh white, with notes of ripe tropical fruits. 12% ABV.

Lively, fresh white with floral aromas. Made from a blend of Grenache Blanc, Clairette & Bourboulenc. Fab house option. 12.5% ABV

Fresh and fruity rosé. Dry from Grenache with a dash of Cinsault, notes of blackcurrant, raspberry and strawberry 12.5% ABV

Our go to certified Organic (and vegan) entry wines, from a co-operative founded in 1932. The secrets of this range are hidden in the vineyard and in the hands of the grape picker. The wines acquire a limitless purity as they are made with the utmost respect for nature surrounded by the Mediterranean flora and fauna in the Alicante hills.

A blend of Airen and Macabeo, this wine has citrus and grapefruit notes, dry, fruity. 12.5%

The Plaimont Co-operative has a justified reputation for consistency of production. Influenced by the Atlantic Ocean to the West and the Pyrennees in the South, this microclimate gives freshness and aromatic typicity to the region's grapes.

The white blend of Ugni Blanc & Colombard, is light, extremely fruity & refreshing with pleasant acidity.

Vignerons Ardechois, France

A co-operative established in 1967 in the beautiful Ardèche region of SE France; the viticultural area stretches from the foothills of the Cevennes Mounains to the Rhone Valley; diurnal temperatures are an important feature with hot days and cool nights. The co-op is committed to cultivating vines in harmony with this stunning environment.

Mainly Sauvignon Blanc, 80% with a dash of Chardonnay from arid limestone and granite soils. Floral, grassy and citrus notes, zippy, fresh. 12.5% ABV

Orelie Blanc , IGP Ardeche, France

This vineyard is located on clay-limestone soils in southern Ardèche, near the "village of character" of Alba la Romaine. Bright, complex nose with aromas of red berries, blackcurrant buds and hints of coffee. A supple and round wine on the palate with tannins present but not aggressive. Unassuming Vin de Pays made by a co-operative near Beziers, fine examples of the type of good quality, but inexpensive wines that can be had from this region.

The Blanc is a blend of 60% Grenache Blanc 20% each of Sauvignon Blanc and Ugni Blanc. Citrus, green apples, dried herbs and white flowers. Refreshing, well-made house wine. 13% ABV

100% Tempranillo, which undergoes carbonic maceration and no oak; Joven style of Rioja. Red fruits — wild raspberry and plum — soft, juicy and approachable. 13% ABV

This domaine produces first class Sauvignon from vines grown on perruche (sandy-clay) soil. The estate is managed according to the Terra Vitis programme, showing a reasoned respect for the environment.

Gooseberries, cut grass and elderflower abounds, classic Loire Sauvignon Blanc. 12% ABV.

Cantina Sociale Frentana, Abruzzo, Italy

Cantina Sociale Frentana is a co-operative of forward-thinking wine makers founded in 1958 and in their translated words, 'aware that the quality of the wine depends first of all on the quality of the fruit.' The winery is located in Rocca San Giovanni, south-west of Pescara. The supreme quality of the terroir allied to the natural ebullience of the grape variety creates something very special. The wine is fermented in the state-of-the-art winery in stainless steel tanks accentuating the natural ripe fruit flavours.

Cantina Sociale Sant'Antonio, Sicily

Cantina Sociale S. Antonio is a Sicilian wine cooperative that only uses its members grapes and redistributes all its profits amongst them. Its fabulous location, cooled by a constant sea breeze from the Gulf of Castellammare, means its growers don't need to use pesticides. Almost all of their wine is still sold locally, in boxes or poured straight into refillable bottles.

Bold, fruity red with plenty of dark cherry and mulberry fruits with earthy hints; 20% of the cuvee has spent maturation time in large old oak. 13% ABV.

Società Agrivinicola Passarini, Verona, Italy

A family-owned vineyard of only five hectares, founded more than 100 years ago by Guido Passarini and run now by his grandsons Luigi and Gianfranco. Three generations later they share a passion for maintaining the family tradition, by respecting their land and continually improving their wines.

Light bodied, delicate and slightly herbaceous, this merlot is a really easy drinker and especially versatile at only 11.5% ABV.

Azienda Agricola Grappolo d'Oro, Friuli, Italy

The Martincigh family are lucky enough to call Azienda Agricola Grappolo d'Oro home. Wine has been produced on all 20 hectares since Roman Times. Its Alpine terraces are perfect for ripening grapes — capturing sun from the south-west, naturally protected from cold northerly winds by the Alps and exposed to a mild ocean breeze from the Adriatic.

Far from bland, this is a spritzy and crisp Pinot Grigio with apple blossom, pears and acacia flowers predominant. 13% ABV

Third generation to produce wine from vineyards which are farmed organically. '47 Anno Domini' sits on the Via Augustus, a Roman route connecting Venice to the plains beyond the Brenner pass, which was completed under the rule of Emperor Claudius Augustus in 47 AD.

These is a Prosecco wine made in a traditional fashion, including the tappo spago cork closure. DOC level and a significant notch up from the mainstream market.
